### GREEN LOCAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION/OEA/NEA SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior accepted to a bachelor's degree program at an accredited four-year college or university with the desire to enter education.

The graduating senior must be accepted and remain in a bachelor's degree program as a declared Education Major at an accredited four-year college or university. The graduating senior must be approved and recommended by the Green Local Education Association and its Scholarship Review Committee using objective criteria developed by the Committee. Interested students must submit the Smithville Local Scholarship Application, letter of intent to be an education major outlining reasons why they should receive the scholarship and at least one letter of recommendation.

The recipient(s) will receive a check from the Green Local Education Association between August 15 and September 15, upon receipt of evidence that tuition/room/board has been paid.

#### MARSHALLVILLE LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

This one-time \$750 scholarship is awarded to a Smithville High School graduating senior accepted as a full-time student in a two-year associate degree or a four-year college program. Applicants will be judged on scholastic aptitude, community and school activity participation, and financial need. The award is to be paid directly to the college and credited to the student's account.

### NATHANIEL DILYARD ART SCHOLARSHIP

This one-time \$500 scholarship is given in memory of Nathaniel Dilyard, who graduated from Smithville High School in 2001 and was attending Malone College majoring in art education. Students applying for this scholarship must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0+ scale and must have taken at least four art classes in high school. (Please indicate number of art classes taken at Smithville High School in application) Please include an essay stating your intended major and reasons for your choice is required. Preference towards students planning to major in art education and then to those majoring in any other art or education related field. Money is paid directly to the student upon completion of one semester of college.

### OSIE AND LEROY FEUSIER SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship shall be a grant of varying dollar amounts each year with at least \$400 awarded to a Smithville High School graduating senior. Preference will be given to a student considering a major in teaching education and having been accepted by a college or university prior to March 15 of the current school year. Other qualifications will be taken into consideration although the applicant must pursue a four-year degree program and have strong academics, strong moral character, and community and school participation.

### SMITHVILLE RURITAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Smithville Ruritan Club awards several scholarships each year to graduating seniors of Smithville High School. Candidates must pursue a two-year associate program, R.N. nursing, or four-year college program and be accepted as full-time students. Based on scholarship, financial need, and moral and ethical character. Money is paid directly to the student upon completion of one semester of college.

#### TUCKER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

An annual non-renewable award of \$750 will be made to one or more seniors of the graduating class of Smithville High School. The major criterion for consideration of winners of this scholarship is service within the Marshallville and Smithville communities. Financial need will also be considered.

#### WYANT'S HAMMER SCHOLARSHIP

A one-time \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior Smithville wrestler or wrestling statistician. Must be attending a two- or four-year educational institution. Candidates must have a strong moral character, a minimum GPA of 3.0, complete the wrestling season in good standing and with a least <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the season completed. Also required is an essay on how wrestling has impacted their life and how it will assist in making future choices and two letters of recommendation from within school/employment (one coach maximum).

#### ED AND PEG KIFER ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to the outstanding senior female and male student athletes. It is determined by a system of points that the student earns through participation, lettering, and advancing to various levels of state competition in each sport. Each athlete will receive \$500 and the student must plan to attend a two-year or four-year college of their choice as a full-time student. **No application required**.

## LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRING SEPARATE APPLICATIONS:

#### All Sports Booster Club Athletic Scholarship

SHS graduating seniors whose parents are active members of the Smithville All Sports Booster Club and who plan to attend a two- or four-year college of their choice as a full-time student. Must have earned two or more varsity letters (including cheerleading), have strong moral character, strong academic achievement, and community and school participation.

Deadline: Must be postmarked by April 15th (separate application)

#### Phyllis Troyer Scholarship

A Smithville High School graduating senior who will be enrolled as a full-time college student majoring in Business/Health Care field. Preference toward students who have academic accomplishments, financial need, and strong moral character.

Deadline: March 31 (separate application)

#### Smithville All-Sports Hall of Fame Scholarship

An annual one-year non-renewable award (no less than \$250) will be given to two Smithville High School graduating athletes. The award will be based on completion of our application, sports accomplishments, leadership and require a GPA of 2.50 or higher. Deadline: March 31 (separate application)
