SUBJECT: SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED STUDENTS

The Wayne County Committee for Crippled Children and Adults, Inc., is once again offering scholarships to those young adults with physical handicaps who wish to continue their education in college or technical school.

We feel that the guidance counselors are in a position to know who these young people are and hope that you would notify such students of the availability of this scholarship and encourage them to apply. The deadline for applying is June 1, 2024.

The Committee of Crippled Children and Adults, Inc., provides scholarships for each academic year a recipient is in school, up to four years, as long as the student is making progress toward graduation. The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000 for the first year and then \$1,500 for the following three years. The Committee would like for the recipients to attend the August meeting each year to give an update on their education and plans for their future.
